Bird dog clubs, rabbit dog clubs, retriever dog clubs, fox hound clubs or other hunting dog clubs wishing to conduct a field trial shall first obtain a Field Trial Permit from the Department which includes authorization for the possession and release of pigeons or pen propagated ring-necked pheasant, northern bobwhite quail, Hungarian partridge, chukar partridge or mallard ducks.
