## **Resident Lifetime Licenses**

A special license offered by the New Hampshire Fish and Game Department for residents of New Hampshire. The following lifetime licenses are available: fishing license, hunting license, combination hunting and fishing license, archery, and a muzzle-loader. These license types are only available at Concord Headquarters or through the mail. This is an opportunity for anyone who expects to continue hunting and/or fishing in the future, because it fixes the cost of a license permanently. The fee for this license is not refundable for any reason. Similar to insurance annuity premiums, the rates are higher at younger ages as shown on the attached fee schedule (effective Jan 1, 2016).

The Lifetime Fishing license does NOT include saltwater fishing.

The Lifetime Hunting and Combination Hunting & Fishing Licenses include the regular bear license. Lifetime License holders do not have pay habitat fees in the ensuing years.

Purchase of a Lifetime License can only be made at the Fish and Game Headquarters or by mail provided the following documentation is presented along with the attached application completed and signed.

- 1. A valid New Hampshire driver license or New Hampshire non-driver photo ID issued by Division of Motor Vehicles.
- 2. A previously held hunting license or hunter safety certificate and/or a previously held archery license or bow education certificate.
- 3. If you currently hold a Lifetime License, you must return it to the Department upon application for additional lifetime licenses. All lifetime license types will be printed on the same form and you will keep the same license number.

If you are applying for a Lifetime Muzzleloader License you must hold a Lifetime Hunting or Combination Hunting and Fishing License.

If applying by mail, please make the check payable to the New Hampshire Fish and Game Department in the amount shown on **the attached fee table at your presently attained age**. The Department cannot be responsible for original documents, only copies of the documents should be mailed. Your license will be mailed back to you, it must be signed. If you would like your license laminated please return it to the Department. If you have any questions please call the Licensing Department at 603-271-3422. Allow 5-10 business days for processing.
