



MOOSE REGISTRATION STATIONS

Moose must be registered by the shooter and permittee at one of the stations below within 24 hours of being killed. Hours vary by location and date as detailed below.

Moose can be registered the day after the hunting season at NH Fish and Game offices in Lancaster, New Hampton, Concord, Keene, and Durham during regular business hours.

WARNING!

CADMIUM IN ORGAN MEATS

The results of a study indicate that consumption of moose liver or kidney may lead to a daily intake of cadmium exceeding recommended levels. Because particularly high cadmium levels have been seen in some moose liver and kidney, the NH Department of Public Health recommends not consuming these organ meats.
