ORDER ON HEARING OF JUNE 18, 2024

A hearing was held on June 18, 2024 to accept, reject, or amend a document entitled “Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendation for Disciplinary Action.” (hereafter “the document”). By a vote of eight “yeas” to one “nay,” the document entitled is adopted by the Commission.

Commissioner Price now seeks a stay of the execution of the recommendation in the document by halting the transmission of the document to the Governor and Executive Council for their consideration. Commissioner Price restated her intention to file a motion for rehearing pursuant to Jus 813.01 et seq. After hearing from both parties, the motion was granted. The document is therefore a final order but subject to rehearing, but it is publicly available. It should be considered an interim order which is still under deliberation, and thus will not be formally transmitted to the Governor and Executive Council as a recommendation for disciplinary action until a motion for rehearing is timely-filed and ruled upon. It is also at this time however a public document in its interim form. If requests for the document are made to the Department prior to rehearing, it may be disseminated but must be prominently marked on its face “subject to rehearing.”

Commissioner Price shall file any motion for rehearing by July 18, 2024. The next deliberative session to consider any motion for rehearing has been set for Monday, July 29, 2024.
