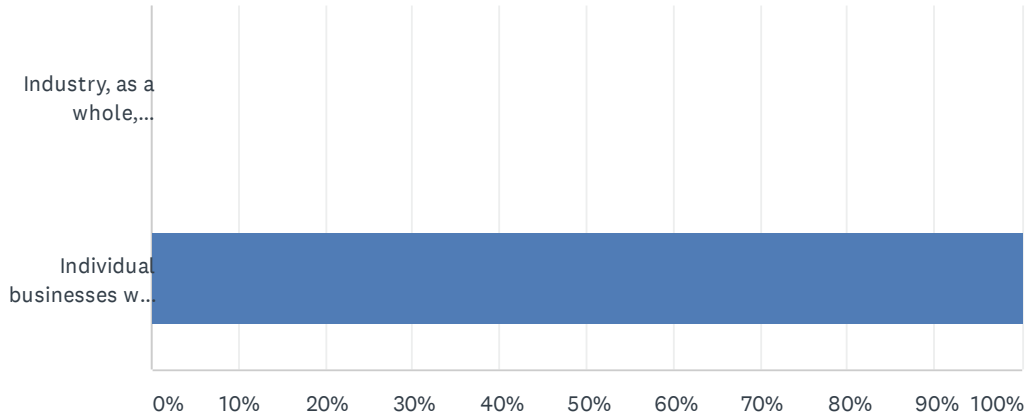


Q1 Should the financial assistance payments be based on individual business losses of >35% in gross revenue or when the industry, as a whole, experiences a >35% loss in gross revenue?

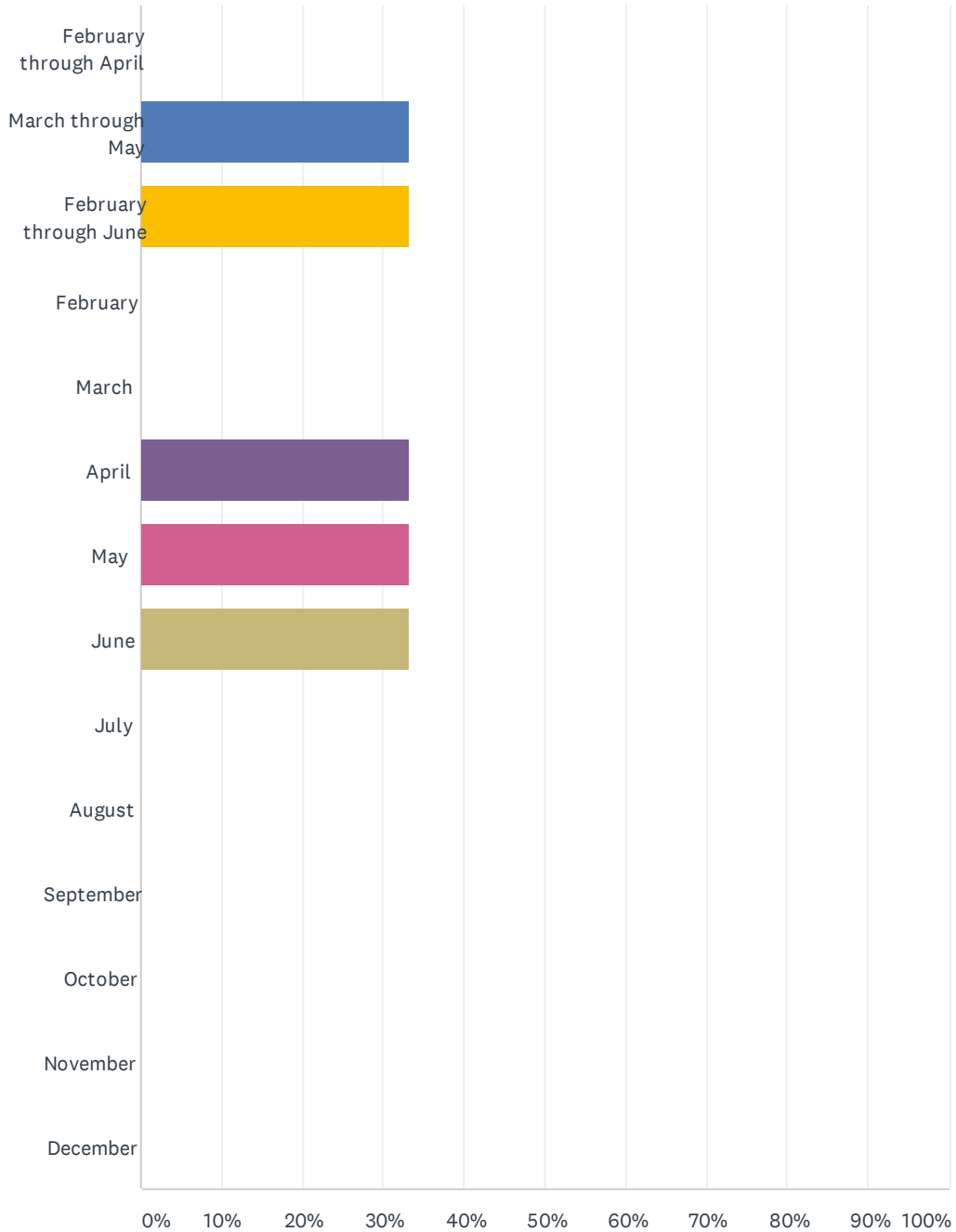

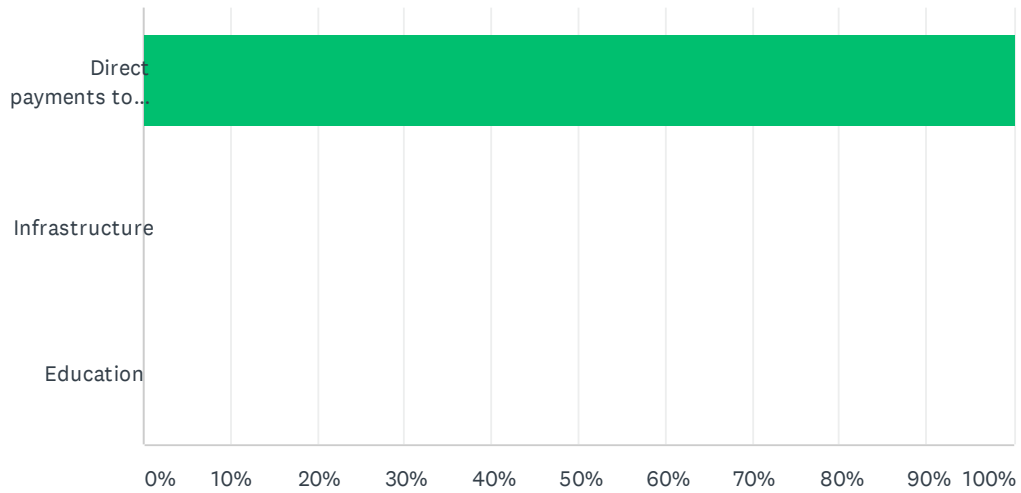

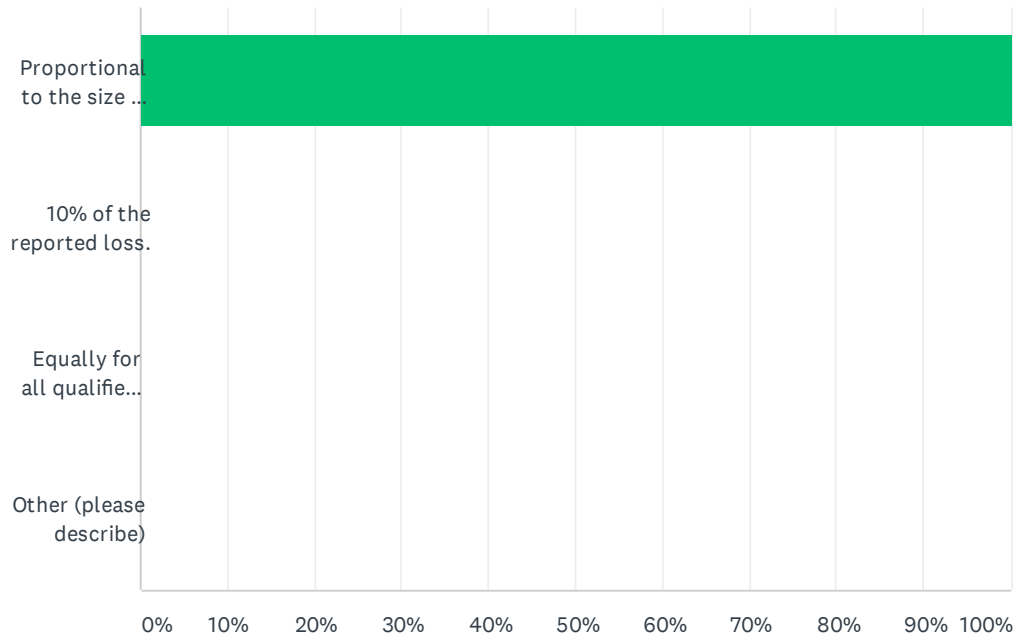

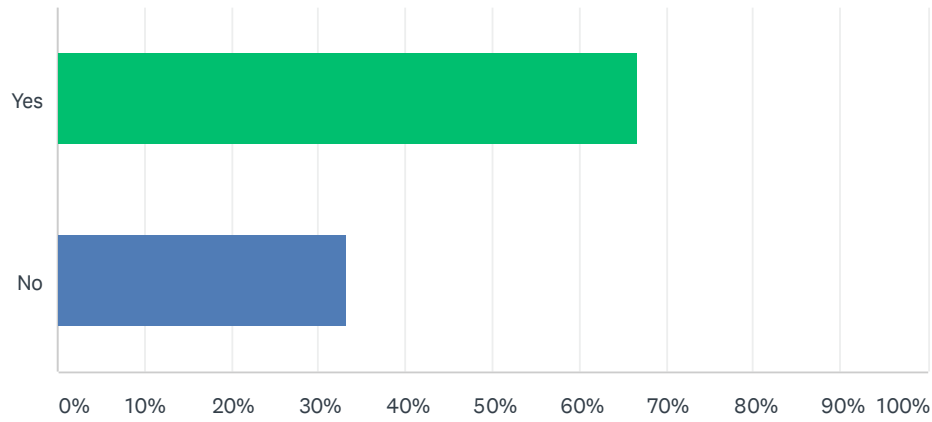
